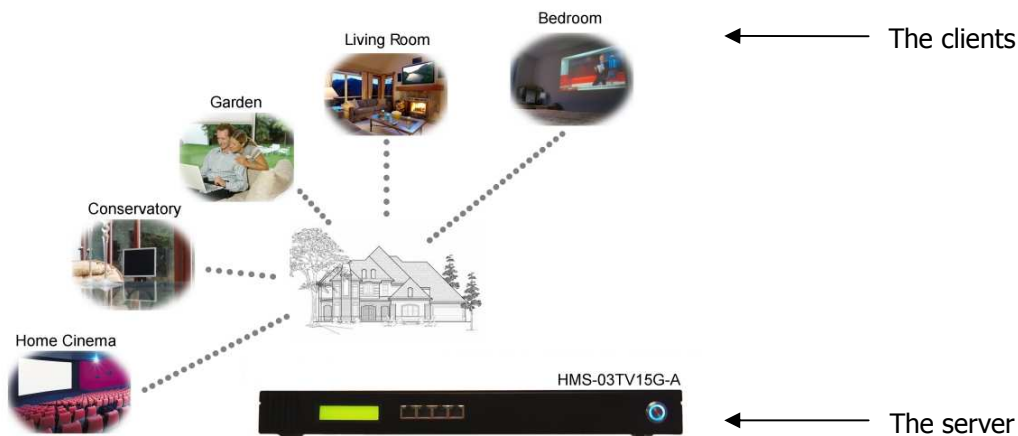


Nebula Home Media Server (HMS) The one-stop solution to your entire home TV needs

What can it do for me?

- One central box (the server) sends TV to up to 5 locations (the clients) in your home.
- Uses your existing local area network (LAN).
- "Clients" can be desktop PCs, laptops or a special receiver/display interface such as our HMC-12G-A (sometimes referred to as a "thin-client").
- Uses 3 Nebula DigiTV Digital terrestrial tuners - allowing advanced viewing and recording of digital Freeview television channels.
- Up to 15 recordings across 15 different channels can be recorded simultaneously, stored on your hard drive and replayed from any of the client PCs.
- The low-profile HMS unit (just 45mm high) is almost silent in operation. It can sit either on full display or hidden away with the rest of your home entertainment equipment.

How does it work?



A single server is connected to your home network and your Aerial connection. This then serves TV and Radio to the clients around the house.
